

## Married Jesus Falsehood

Today, there is a strong undercurrent of doctrines throughout all forms of media to deny, deprecate and dishonour Jesus. This is very apparent in recent days and weeks of purported new evidence which proclaims that Jesus was married when he was here on this earth.

I would like to state unequivocally by the word of God that the only begotten Son of God, Jesus was NOT married.

I would like to share a few passages from the word of God that leave no room for doubt, discussion or debate about whether Jesus was indeed unmarried.

In the last days of time on this earth before Jesus was crucified, “A certain scribe came, and said unto Jesus, ‘Master; I will follow thee whithersoever thou goest.’ And Jesus saith unto him, ‘The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head’” (Matthew 8:19–20).

By this world’s standards a married man would have desired to go home!

“At a time when many of us are solely consumed with accumulating wealth and living for the cares of this world, these words of the Son of God should resonate in our minds, hearts, and souls: “The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head.” These words should also put into perspective the purpose of our life on this earth. Jesus did not come to this earth to build great wealth and to live in a palace. He came to teach and preach about the record of commandment given to him by his Father, which is the reward of inheritance available to all humankind” (Passage to Paradise: Time is coming to an End, Ch. 7, p. 113).

“In the beginning was the *Word*, and the *Word* was with God, and the *Word* was God. The same was in the beginning with God” (John 1:1–2).

“And the *Word* was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth” (John 1:14).

The *Word* of God, made flesh and full of grace and *truth*, is the Son of God.

God, “hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him” (2 Corinthians 5:21).

When Jesus came to this earth, he came as the *Word* of God (John 1:1) to bear witness of the *truth*.

What is *truth*?

Jesus, the first begotten of the dead, is the King of *saints* and is of the highest order of priests, of the order of Melchizedek (Genesis 14: 18-19).

At the end of time, the firstfruits to be redeemed from this earth are the high priesthood of saints of God and the Son of God.

“And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father’s name written in their foreheads” (Revelation 14:1).

“These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb. And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God” (Revelation 14:4).

Jesus, the King of Saints, just as his firstfruits of high priesthood of saints has never been with women; they are virgins.

“And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals. And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?” (Revelation 5:1–2).

“And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon” (Revelation 5:2–3), except “the Lamb, who came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne” (Revelation 5:7).

At the end of time, the only *one* who is worthy to open the seven seals of the book is Jesus, who is *perfect* and is of the highest order of priests; the *King of Saints*.

“Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God? This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth. For there are three that bear record in heaven, the *Father*, the *Word*, and the *Holy Ghost*: and these three are one. And there are three that bear witness in earth, the *spirit*, and the *water*, and the *blood*: and these three agree in one” (1 John 5:5–8).

Do not be misled by falsehoods which are not supported by the word of God.
