Lesson One: God has Seven Spirits

God is the most High God and is from everlasting to everlasting. God has always existed and will exist forever (Psalm 92:8). God inhabits eternity.

“O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! Who hast set thy glory above the heavens” (Psalm 8:1).

God owns all things including this heaven and earth. We humans are also God’s creations (Genesis 1:26-27, 2:7). God created all things for his own pleasure (Revelation 4:11). We only have to try to imagine this being human how we feel when we have joy in our own life. When God created this heaven and earth, he saw the result of the works of his hands and “and God saw that it was good” (Genesis 1:1-18).

As the only Creator, God commanded humans to worship him only. For those of us who are parents, being there for our children, loving and providing all things for them; how would we feel if our children always were disobedient, did not love us and went to love strangers instead? We would be most unhappy, to say the least, livid! So too God’s first commandment is: “Thou shalt have no other gods before me” (Exodus 20:3). So too, God expects human beings to worship him only. After all, “Know ye that the Lord he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people and the sheep of his pasture” (Psalm 100:3).

Since the beginning of time, God declared, “For all the earth is mine” (Exodus 19:5).

“The sea is his, and he made it: and his hands formed the dry *land*. The earth is the Lord’s, and the fullness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein” (Psalms 95:5, 24:1).

There are a whole lot of things that we do not know about God and all his creations. However, God has given us his word that all will be revealed at the end of time (Revelation 10:7). However, God wants us to worship him in truth and in spirit.

Today, many of us are so bamboozled by technological gadgets and are too busy looking down talking, texting and typing that they may not be aware that precious time is being lost by the minute in this lifetime. The fundamental purpose is to come to knowledge through the word of God about the *truth* about our lifetime here on earth.
