

Lesson Two: Jesus is the only begotten Son of God

There is a “tsunami of doctrines” that aims to misconstrue the word of God. Specifically, many are saying that it was Jesus who created the heaven and earth. Many hold beliefs that God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit are the same. But, this is blatantly incorrect!

Jesus is the *faithful and true witness* of God. There are three that bear witness in heaven, The *Father*, the *Word* and the *Spirit*; and these three agree as one (1 John 5:7). God is seven Spirits (Revelation 4:5). God gave to his only begotten Son without measure the seven Spirits (John 33:34) (Revelation 3:1). The *Word* of God is Jesus. Before the heavens and earth were created, Jesus was created by the most High God.

Jesus “is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature. For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: And he is before all things, and by him all things consist” (Colossians 1:15–17).

“For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour. Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet” (Psalm 8:5-6).

“For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones” (Isaiah 57:15).

Jesus is also the everlasting King.

“Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord of hosts, he is the King of glory. Selah” (Psalm 24:7-10).

“Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father” (1 John 2:23).
